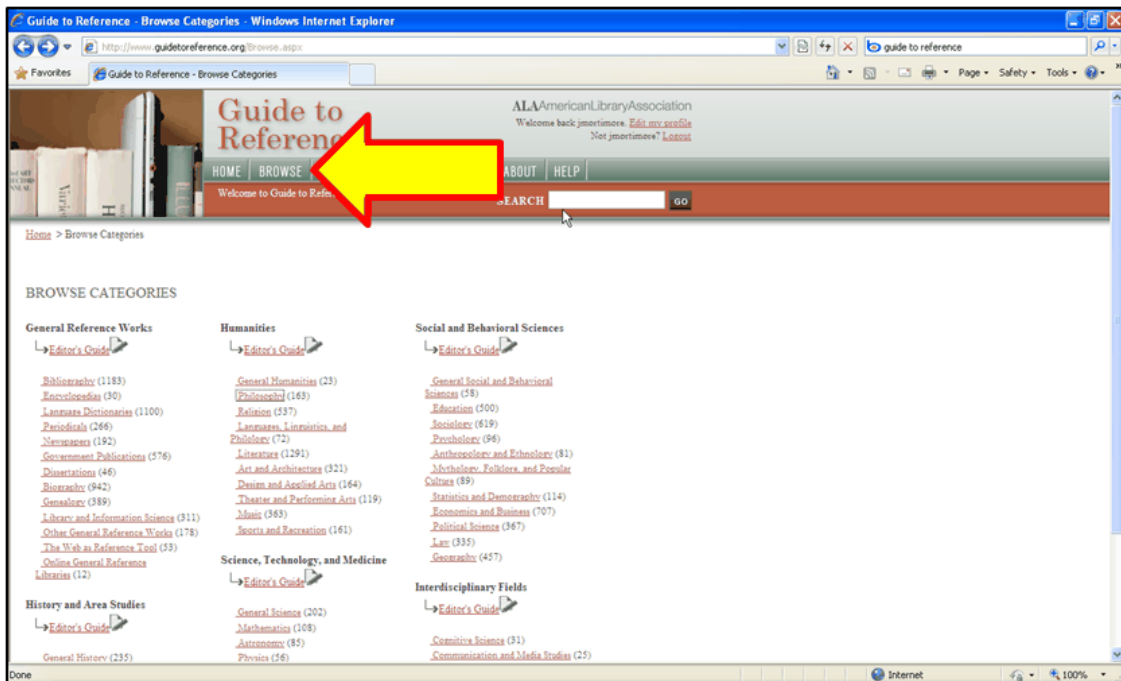


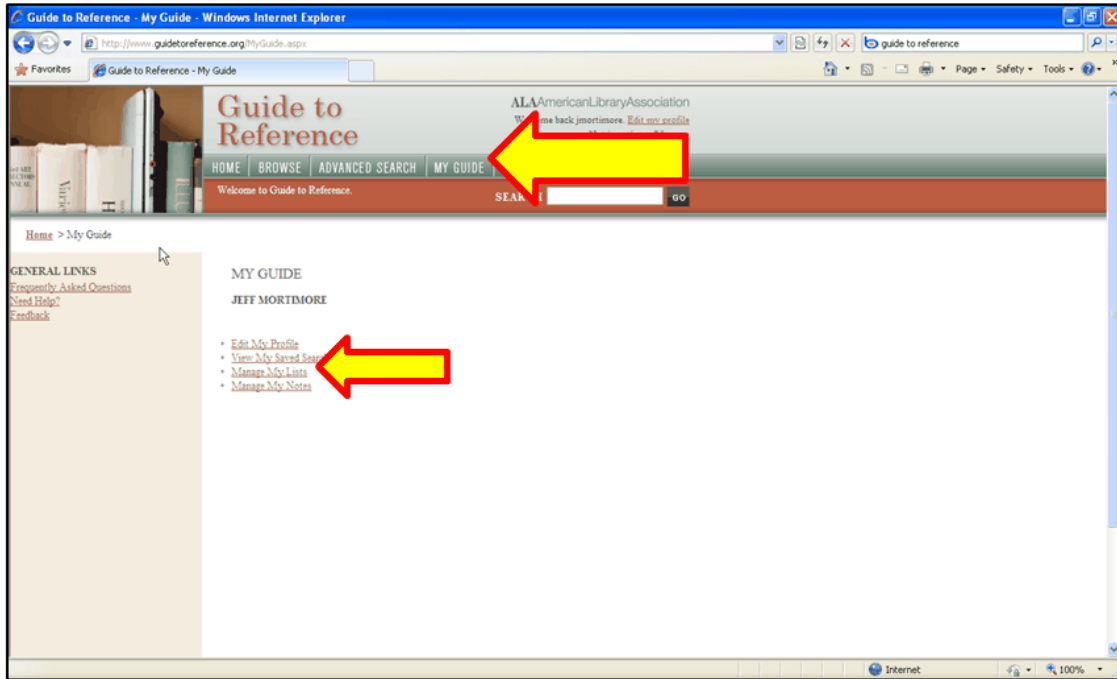
Create a Want list with Guide to Reference.

Guide to Reference is an online database for locating reference books in a range of different disciplines. Guide to Reference may be searched by discipline, keywords, and subjects. Using this method to prepare a request list **does** require you to create and use a free 60-day account.

1. Go to <http://www.guidetoreference.org/trialregistration.aspx> and set up your free 60-day account. Once you are logged in, click on the “browse” tab to browse titles by subject area or use the search box or “advanced search” tab to search titles by keyword.



- As you browse your returns, select items you would like to recommend by clicking the select box and then clicking the “add to list” link. Add your items to an existing or new list. Once you are done adding items to your list, click the “my guide” tab, then the “manage my lists” link to access your list.



3. Open your list by clicking on it. Select all titles, then click on the “email” link to email your list to your library liaison.
